

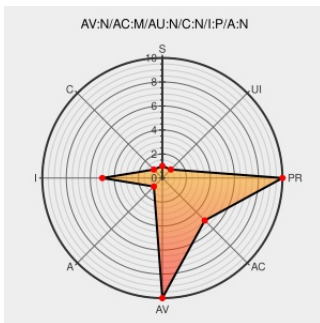

Cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in phpXplorer 0.9.12 and earlier allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via the address bar field.
