

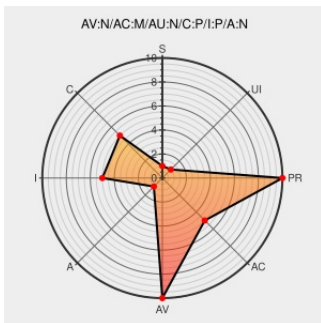

Cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in index.cfm in Hot Banana Web Content Management Suite 5.3 allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via the keywords parameter.
