

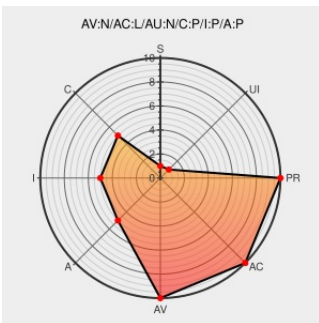

SQL injection vulnerability in tickets.php in cSupport 1.0 and earlier allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the pg parameter.
