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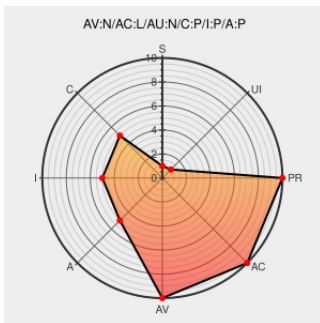

SQL injection vulnerability in poll_frame.php in Vote! Pro 4.0 and earlier allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the poll_id parameter.
