

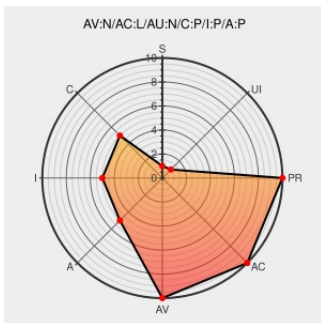

Multiple SQL injection vulnerabilities in list.php in Complete PHP Counter allow remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the (1) c or (2) s parameter.
