

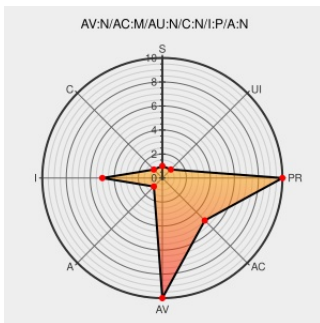

Cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in search.php in Siteframe 5.0.1 allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via the q parameter.
