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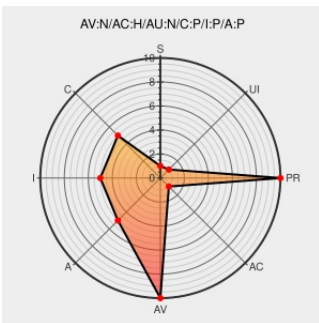

Multiple SQL injection vulnerabilities in loginprocess.php in qliteNews 2005.07.01 allow remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the (1) username or (2) password parameters.
