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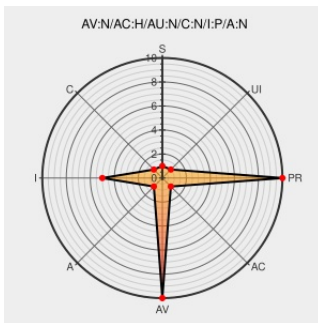

Certain versions of [Arab Portal](#) from [Arab Portal](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Multiple cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerabilities in Arab Portal 2.0.1 stable allow remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via the (1) adminJump and (2) forum\_middle parameters in (a) forum.php, and the (3) form parameter in (b) members.php, (c) pm.php, and (d) mail.php.
