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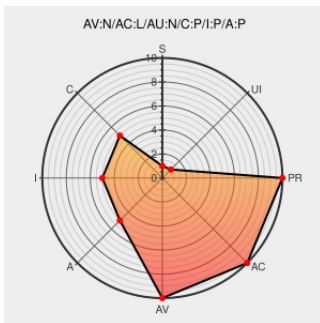

Buy.php in Aweb Scripts Seller uses predictable cookies for authentication based on the time and the script number, which allows remote attackers to bypass authentication.
