

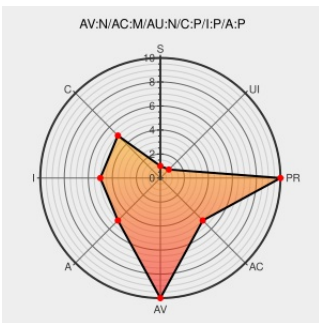

Cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in index.php in JBook 1.3 allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via the page parameter.
