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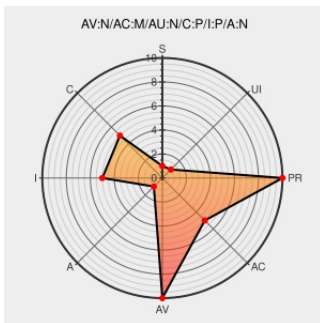

Cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in news/NsVisitor.cgi in KCScripits News Publisher, distributed individually and as part of Portal Pack 6.0 and earlier, allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via the sort_order parameter.
