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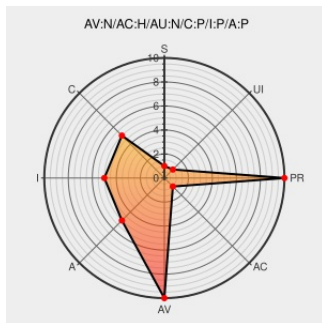

admin/upprocess.php in DGNews 1.5 and earlier allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code by uploading scripts with arbitrary extensions to the img directory.
