

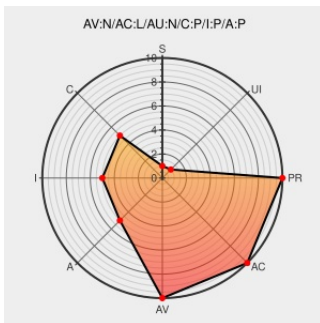

SQL injection vulnerability in Anket.asp in ASPSite 2.0 and earlier allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the hid parameter.
