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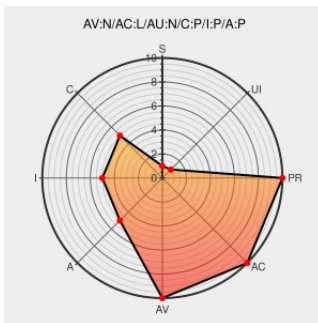

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Certain versions of [Contacts Xtd Component](#) from [Mambo](#) contain the following vulnerability:

**** DISPUTED **** PHP remote file inclusion vulnerability in `contxtd.class.php` in the Contacts XTD (ContXTD) component for Mambo (`com_contxtd`) allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary PHP code via a URL in the `mosConfig_absolute_path` parameter.

NOTE: another researcher has disputed this issue, saying that the software prevents the attack by checking whether `_VALID_MOS` is defined.

CVE-2006-4375 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability
