Description	PHP remote file inclusion vulnerability in system/_b/contentFiles/gbHTMLEditor.php in BolinOS 4.5.5 and earlier allows remote file inclusion via the 'include' parameter. The vulnerability exists in the 'include' parameter of the 'includeFile' function. An attacker can craft a request to include a remote file, such as a web shell, which can be used to execute arbitrary code on the target system.
