

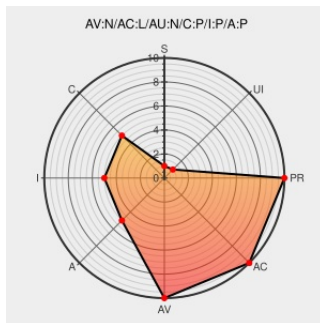

Certain versions of [Phpmyadmin](#) from [Phpmyadmin](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Multiple CRLF injection vulnerabilities in PhpMyAdmin 2.7.0-pl2 allow remote attackers to inject arbitrary HTTP headers and conduct HTTP response splitting attacks via CRLF sequences in a phpMyAdmin cookie in (1) `css/phpmyadmin.css.php`, (2) `db_create.php`, (3) `index.php`, (4) `left.php`, (5) `libraries/session.inc.php`, (6)

`libraries/transformations/overview.php`, (7) `querywindow.php`, (8) `server_engines.php`, and possibly other files.
