Description	Multiple directory traversal vulnerabilities in Open Solution Quick.Cart 2.0, when register_globals is enabled and magic_quotes_gpc is disabled, an attacker can traverse the file system and read arbitrary files. This vulnerability is caused by the fact that the Quick.Cart 2.0 does not properly sanitize the user input before using it to construct the file path. The vulnerability is present in the Quick.Cart 2.0.0 to 2.0.10 versions.
