

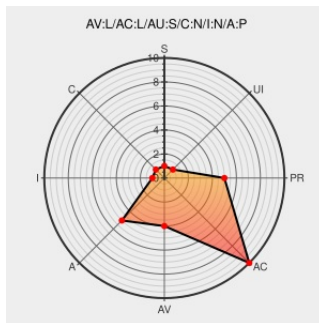

Certain versions of [Netbsd](#) from [Netbsd](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The procfs implementation in NetBSD-current before 20061023, NetBSD 3.0 and 3.0.1 before 20061024, and NetBSD 2.x before 20061029 allows local users to cause a denial of service (kernel panic) by attempting to access `/emul/linux/proc/0/stat` on a procfs filesystem that was mounted with `mount_procfs -o linux`, which results in a NULL

pointer dereference.
