

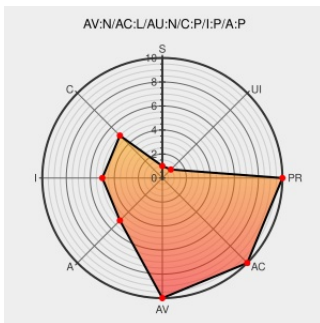

PHP remote file inclusion vulnerability in include/includes.php in Bradabra 2.0.5 and earlier allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary PHP code via a URL in the include_path parameter.
