

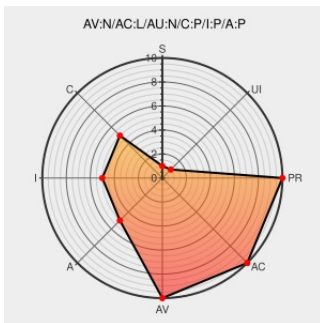

Certain versions of [Weather Module](#) from [Antonis Ventouris](#) contain the following vulnerability:

PHP remote file inclusion vulnerability in mod\_weather.php in the Antonis Ventouris Weather module for Mambo and Joomla! allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary PHP code via a URL in the absolute\_path parameter.
