

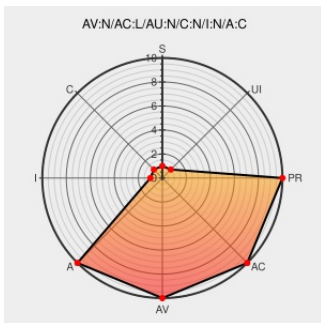

MiniShare 1.5.4, and possibly earlier, allows remote attackers to cause a denial of service (application crash) via a flood of requests for new connections.
