Certain versions of [Safari](#) from [Apple](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Multiple unspecified vulnerabilities in Apple Safari for Windows allow remote attackers to cause a denial of service or execute arbitrary code, possibly involving memory corruption, and a different issue from CVE-2007-3185 and CVE-2007-3186. NOTE: as of 20070612, the original disclosure has no actionable information. However, since it is from a well-known researcher, it is being assigned a CVE identifier for tracking

purposes.
