

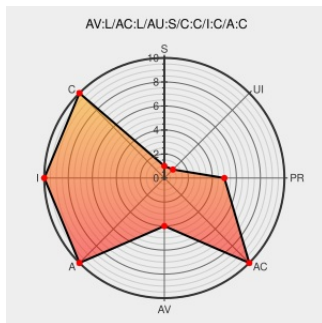

Certain versions of [Solaris](#) from [Sun](#) contain the following vulnerability: GNOME XScreenSaver in Sun Solaris 8 and 9 before 20070417, when root is logged into the console, does not automatically lock the screen after a session has been inactive, which might allow physically proximate attackers to access the console.
