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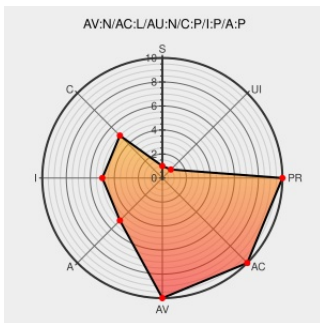

SQL injection vulnerability in print.php in the Articles 1.02 and earlier module for Xoops allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the id parameter.
