

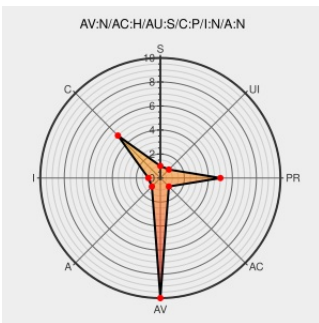

vtiger CRM before 5.0.3, when a migrated build is used, allows remote authenticated users to read certain other users' calendar activities via a (1) home page or (2) event list view.
