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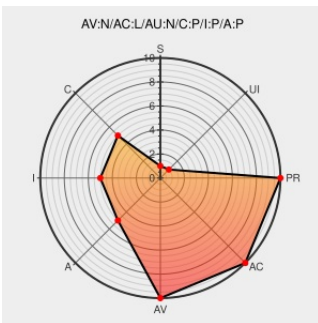

PHP remote file inclusion vulnerability in example/gamedemo/inc.functions.php in PHP Comet-Server allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary PHP code via a URL in the projectPath parameter.
