

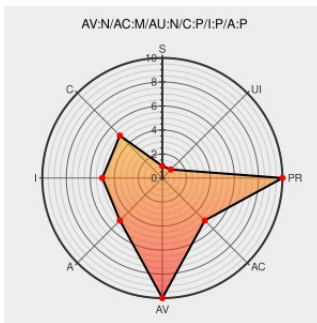

Certain versions of [123 Flash Chat Module](#) from [Phpbb](#) contain the following vulnerability:

**** DISPUTED **** Multiple PHP remote file inclusion vulnerabilities in the 123 Flash Chat Module for phpBB allow remote attackers to execute arbitrary PHP code via a URL in the phpbb_root_path parameter to (1) 123flashchat.php and (2) phpbb_login_chat.php. NOTE: CVE disputes this issue because \$phpbb_root_path is explicitly set to "/" in both

programs.
