Description	The PXE Server (pxesrv.exe) in Acronis Snap Deploy 2.0.0.1076 and earlier allows remote attackers to cause a denial of service (DoS) by sending a crafted TFTP request to the server, which causes the server to crash. The vulnerability exists because the server does not properly validate the length of the TFTP request. This vulnerability is present in Acronis Snap Deploy 2.0.0.1076 and earlier.
