Certain versions of [Homeph Design](#) from [Homeph Design](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Multiple cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerabilities in HomePH Design 2.10 RC2 allow remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via the (1) error_meldung parameter to admin/features/register/register.php, the (2) feature_language[ueberschrift] parameter to

admin/features/memberlist/memberlist.php, the (3) language_array[ueberschrift] parameter to admin/features/lostpassword/lostpassword.php, the (4) language_feature[titel] parameter to admin/features/kalender/eingabe.php, and the (5) language_feature[bildmenu] parameter to admin/features/fotogalerie/eingabe.php.
