Description	Multiple cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerabilities in index.php in the Bluemoon PopnupBLOG module 3.20 and 3.30 for XOOPS 2.0.10 and 2.0.11. The vulnerabilities are located in the index.php file, which is responsible for displaying the blog content. The vulnerabilities are caused by insufficient input validation and output encoding, allowing an attacker to inject malicious code into the page. This can lead to various attacks, including session hijacking, defacement, and data theft.
