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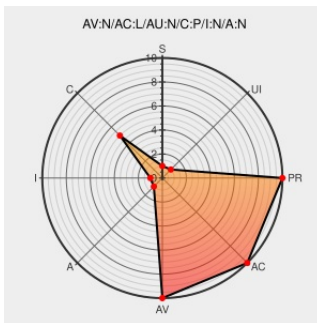

Certain versions of [Phpbb](#) from [Phpbb](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The search function in phpBB 2.x provides a search\_id value that leaks the state of PHP's PRNG, which allows remote attackers to obtain potentially sensitive information, as demonstrated by a cross-application attack against WordPress, a different vulnerability than CVE-2006-0632.
