

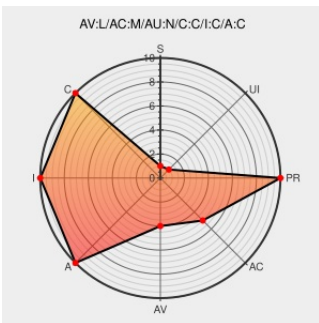

Certain versions of [Xen](#) from [Xen](#) contain the following vulnerability:
qemu-dm.debug in Xen 3.2.1 allows local users to overwrite arbitrary files via a symlink attack on the /tmp/args temporary file.
