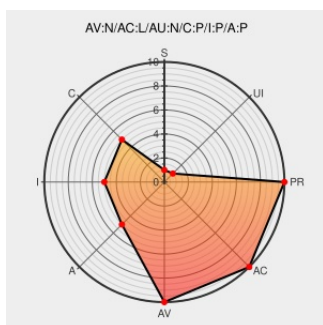

SQL injection vulnerability in view\_reviews.php in Scripts for Sites (SFS) EZ Gaming Cheats allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the id parameter.
