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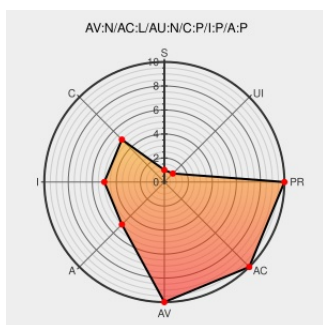

Certain versions of [Wyse Device Manager](#) from [Dell](#) contain the following vulnerability:

hagent.exe in Wyse Device Manager (WDM) 4.7.x does not require authentication for commands, which allows remote attackers to obtain management access via a crafted query, as demonstrated by a V52 query that triggers a power-off action.
