Description	Unspecified vulnerability in the Advanced Queuing component in Oracle Database 10.1.0.5, 10.2.0.4, and 11.1.0.7 allows remote authenticated users to execute arbitrary code and cause a denial of service (DoS) via a crafted SQL statement. The vulnerability exists because the Advanced Queuing component does not properly validate the length of the SQL statement, which can lead to a buffer overflow. This vulnerability is not present in Oracle Database 11.2.0.4 and later.
