

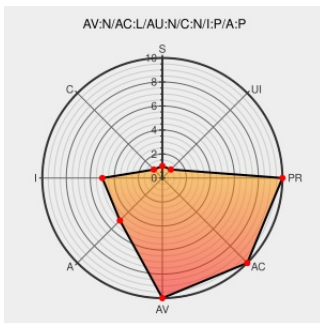

SQL injection vulnerability in index.php in LightOpenCMS 0.1 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the id parameter.
