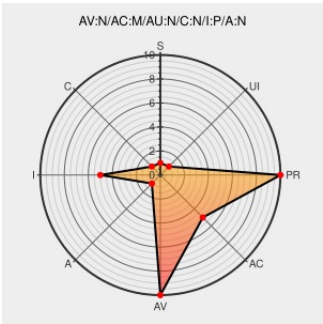

Multiple cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerabilities in TBDev.NET 01-01-08 allow remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via (1) the returto parameter to makepoll.php, (2) the returto parameter in a delete action to polls.php, or the (3) Info or (4) Avatar field to my.php.
