

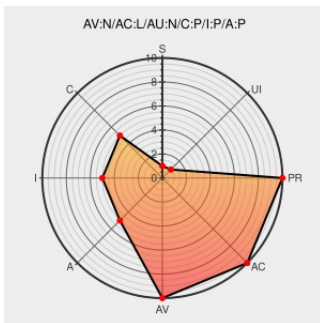

SQL injection vulnerability in a_index.php in AdaptWeb 0.9.2 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the CodigoDisciplina parameter in a TopicosCadastro1 action.
