Certain versions of [Mantisbt](#) from [Mantisbt](#) contain the following vulnerability:

MantisBT 1.2.x before 1.2.2 insecurely handles attachments and MIME types. Arbitrary inline attachment rendering could lead to cross-domain scripting or other browser attacks.

CVE-2009-2802 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
