

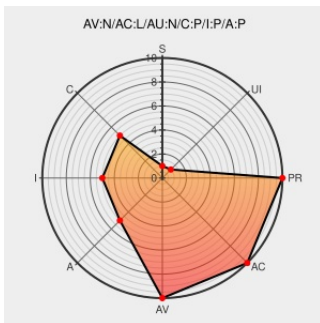

SQL injection vulnerability in DetailFile.php in DigitalSpinners DS CMS 1.0 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the nFileId parameter.
