

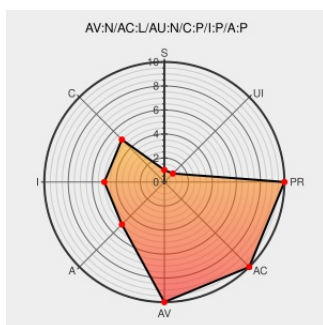

SQL injection vulnerability in show-cat.php in FanUpdate 2.2.1 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the listingid parameter.
