

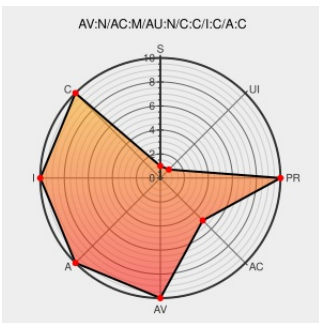

Stack-based buffer overflow in Winplot 1.25.0.1 allows user-assisted remote attackers to execute arbitrary code via a crafted Plot2D (.wp2) file.
