

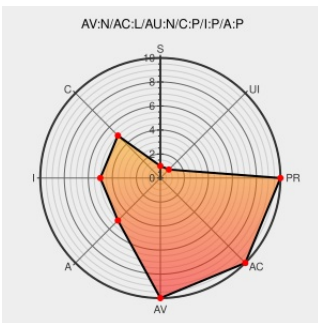

SQL injection vulnerability in the TurtuShout component 0.11 for Joomla! allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the Name field.
