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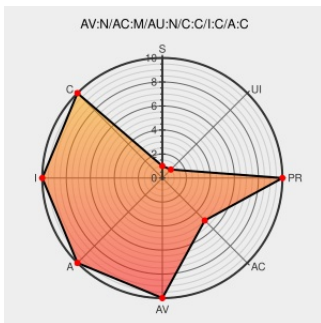

Tuniac 090517c allows remote attackers to cause a denial of service (crash) or possibly execute arbitrary code via a long File1 argument in a .pls playlist file, possibly a buffer overflow.
