

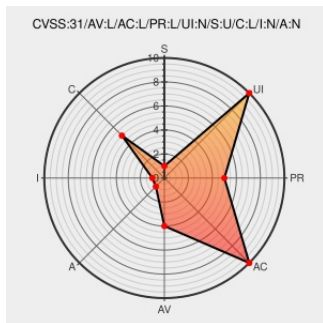

liboping 1.3.2 allows users reading arbitrary files upon the local system.
