Certain versions of [Rios](#) from [Riorey](#) contain the following vulnerability:

RioRey RIOS 4.6.6 and 4.7.0 uses an undocumented, hard-coded username (dbadmin) and password (sqlus3r) for an SSH tunnel, which allows remote attackers to gain privileges via port 8022.
