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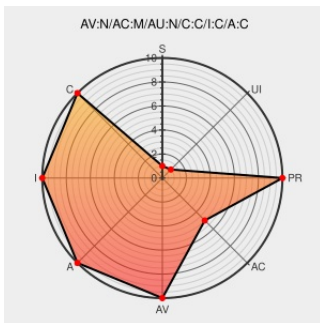

Stack-based buffer overflow in A2 Media Player Pro 2.51 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code via a long string in a (1) .m3u or (2) .m3l playlist file.
