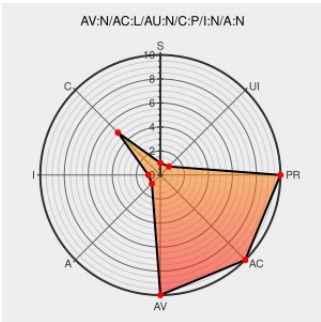

Certain versions of [Seamonkey](#) from [Mozilla](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Mozilla Necko, as used in Thunderbird 3.0.1, SeaMonkey, and other applications, performs DNS prefetching even when the app type is `APP_TYPE_MAIL` or `APP_TYPE_EDITOR`, which makes it easier for remote attackers to determine the network location of the application's user by logging DNS requests, as demonstrated by DNS requests for `smtp://` and `news://` in Thunderbird.

CVE-2009-4629 has been assigned by cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability
