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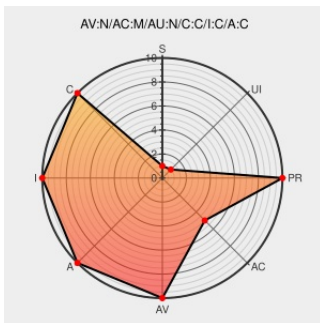

Stack-based buffer overflow in KSP 2006 FINAL allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code via a long string in a .M3U playlist file.
