

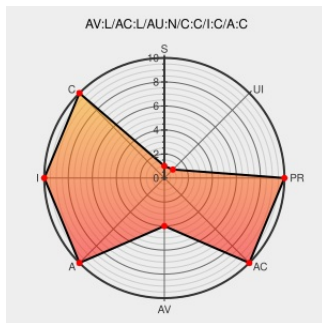


# CVE-2009-4997

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## CVE-2009-4997

Certain versions of **Power Manager** from **Gnome** contain the following vulnerability:

gnome-power-manager 2.27.92 does not properly implement the lock\_on\_suspend and lock\_on\_hibernate settings for locking the screen when the suspend or hibernate button is pressed, which might make it easier for physically proximate attackers to access an unattended laptop via a resume action, a related issue to CVE-2010-

2532. NOTE: this issue exists because of a regression that followed a gnome-power-manager fix a few years earlier.

CVE-2009-4997 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability
